Scripture Spotlight

Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."



CHAPTER SUMMARY

Acts 1 shows the risen Jesus teaching His apostles, promising the Holy Spirit, and ascending into heaven. The believers return to Jerusalem, pray together, and seek God's direction as Matthias is chosen to take Judas's place among the apostles.



CORE TRUTH

Jesus did not leave His followers without direction or help. He gave them a mission, promised the Holy Spirit's power, and taught them to wait on God before moving forward.



DID YOU KNOW?

Acts begins as the second part of Luke's account to Theophilus. Luke first wrote about what Jesus did and taught on earth. Acts continues the story by showing how the risen Christ worked through His apostles by the Holy Spirit.
